Augmentative/Alternative Communication (AAC)

If you answered “yes” to either of the above questions, your child may benefit from an AAC evaluation. Augmentative and alternative communication systems provide a way for children with limited verbal skills to communicate their wants, needs and thoughts to others. By enabling a child’s ability to communicate, behavior problems often decrease. Communication through an AAC device can enable children to better demonstrate their cognitive and academic abilities. Contrary to what many people think, using an augmentative communication system does not prevent children from being verbal—it actually helps verbalization. Our staff is trained in assisting children with AAC systems. We can provide an initial evaluation, therapy to develop proficiency, train users, and assist with device set up.

In our “Communication Station” group, children with AAC systems improve their social language skills. Children learn to use their device to supplement their social communication.
